

Everyone knows that dogs are like family. And as such, the good boys and girls of the family deserve to

be treated every once in a while. Below are 3 super simple, yet delicious recipes to make for the furry children in your life.


This treat requires only two ingredients and is quick to make. You simply need one cup of organic wheat flour and one 4oz. jar of baby food. Mix together in a bowl, roll out dough and punch out into your favorite shapes, then cook in the oven at 325 degrees for 30-45 minutes, depending on desired crunch. Be sure to use a baby food that is safe for dogs. We recommend blueberry, beef, or sweet potato.

To help your pooch beat the summer heat, try this delicious treat. This healthy recipe provides tons of vitamins and fiber by using two apples, 1 cup of nonfat plain yogurt, and water. After deseeding the apples and cutting into slices, mix all the slices, all the yogurt, and just a splash of water into a blender, and blend until it reaches a liquid consistency. Pour the mixture into an ice cube tray and place into the freezer for a few hours until you have hard cubes. The final product should be a hard, but creamy treat for your dog to chew on and cool down with.

3 Ingredient Gluten Free Treats For A Grain Free Diet For dogs with grain allergies or on a grain free diet, this is the perfect alternative. The three ingredients are grain free flour (oat, rice, etc), all natural peanut butter (be sure to get pb with real sugar as xylitol sweetener is toxic to dogs), and bananas. Mix one and a half cups of the flour, 3 ripe mashed bananas, and one-third of a cup of peanut butter together in a bowl. Roll the dough out and then punch into your favorite shapes. Cook in oven at 325 degrees for 25-30 minutes.
